Follow the Signs

Overhead signs give motorists information they need when considering I-4 Express as an option. Toll rates are displayed on electronic signs before entering the lanes. You'll only pay for the distance you drive.

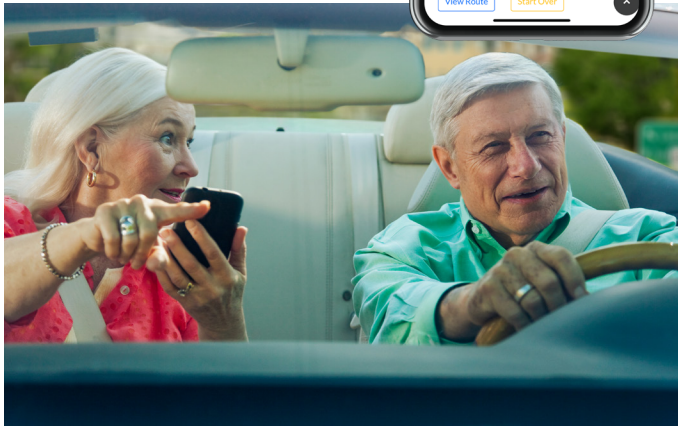
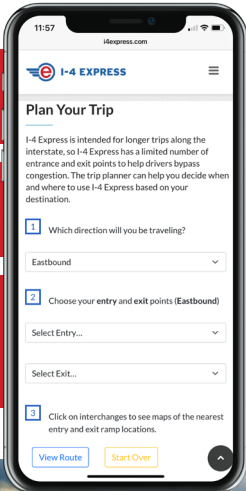
Amounts shown are for example only. Pricing is not a fixed rate and it will change based on demand.

As you approach exit points, you'll see additional pricing signs well in advance to help you decide whether to exit or continue your trip on I-4 Express.

Map It Out

I-4 Express is a limited-access road within the interstate. Entry and exit points are available at select locations. You can visit [i4express.com](https://www.i4express.com) to use the trip planner to see if I-4 Express is an option based on your destination.

1. Identify the direction you're headed
2. Select where you'd enter I-4 Express
3. Choose where to exit I-4 Express from available ramps



When you're behind the wheel, ask a passenger to look up directions, answer phone calls, and respond to texts. Avoid driving distracted. Put it down. It can wait.

Florida's Turnpike
Direct connect exit ramp from WB I-4 Express to SB Florida's Turnpike
Direct connect entrance ramp from NB Florida's Turnpike to EB I-4 Express

Kirkman Road via Grand National Drive
Direct connect entrance & exit ramps to and from WB I-4 Express at Grand National Drive
Direct connect entrance & exit ramps to and from EB I-4 Express at Grand National Drive

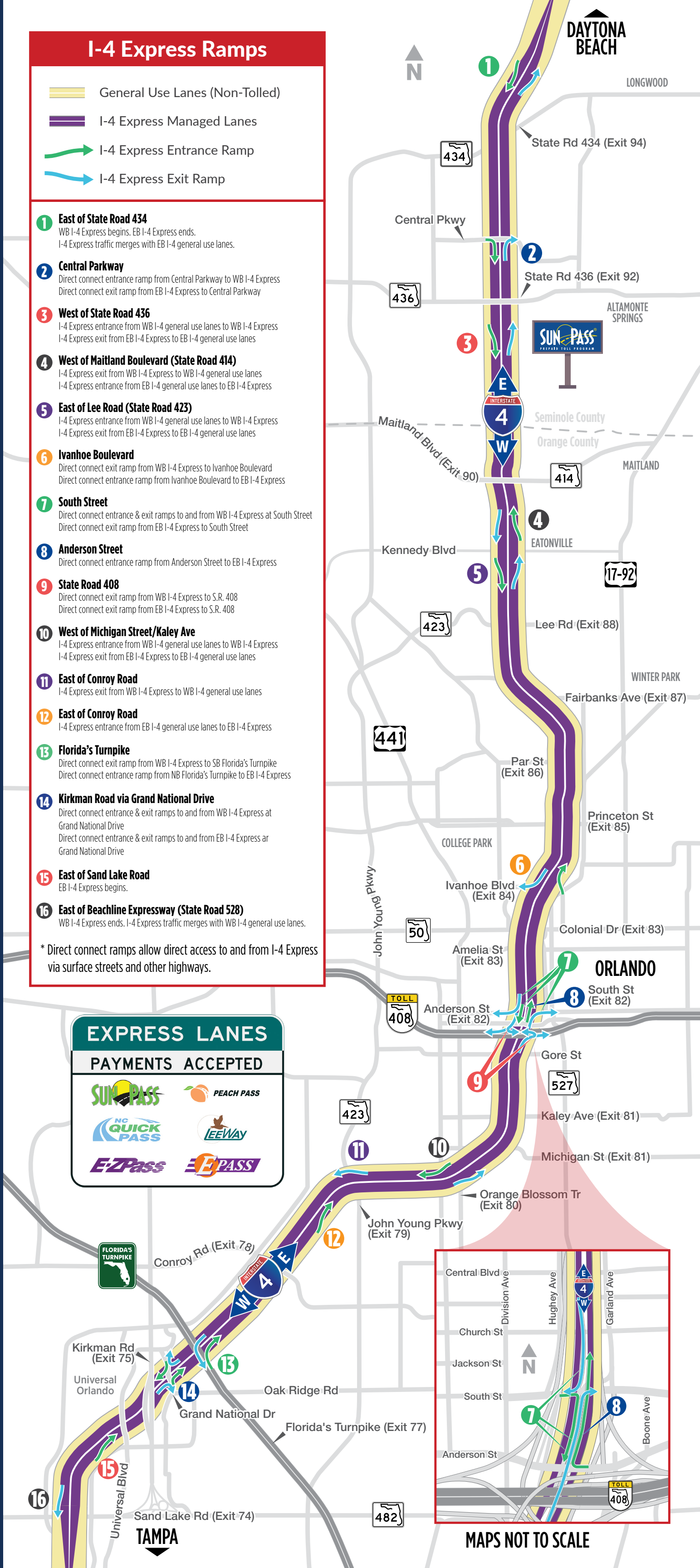
East of Sand Lake Road
EB I-4 Express begins.

East of Beachline Expressway (State Road 528)
WB I-4 Express ends. I-4 Express traffic merges with WB I-4 general use lanes.

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is providing motorists choices with managed lane options on some of its most heavily traveled highways. Managed lanes are highway lanes where operational strategies are proactively implemented to address congestion. Examples of managed lanes include reversible lanes, high-occupancy vehicle (HOV) lanes, and express lanes. I-4 Express is FDOT's managed lanes approach on Interstate 4 (I-4) in Orange and Seminole counties.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. Why are there only a limited number of designated entrance and exit points to access I-4 Express?

The access points are designed to serve long-distance, regional trips in order to bypass congested areas.

Q. What vehicles are allowed to use I-4 Express?

Any two-axle vehicle equipped with an active, properly mounted SunPass or other Florida-accepted transponder can use I-4 Express. Trucks with three or more axles and passenger vehicles pulling trailers or boats are not permitted.

Electronic Toll Collection Only

SunPass is the official transponder of I-4 Express, but drivers do have additional options. Several transponders are accepted in Florida.



All tolls are collected electronically at highway speed, so there is no need to slow down when driving under an overhead gantry. There is no cash or TOLL-BY-PLATE option. Motorists must have a transponder to use I-4 Express. A \$25 toll violation plus the cost of tolls will be enforced for drivers who don't have a Florida-accepted transponder.
